ILEC is a Cambridge ESOL exam (exam for English Speakers of Other Languages) produced and assessed by Cambridge University.

It is recognised by leading associations of lawyers including the European Company Lawyers Association, the European Law Students Association, the International Association of Young Lawyers, and the European Young Bar Association.

Examinations will take place in May and November at Cambridge ESOL Exam Centres in Germany.

The Objectives

- Assess candidates' ability to operate in English in an international legal environment.
- Allow candidates to demonstrate to employers their ability to communicate in English with clients and colleagues.
- Allow candidates to demonstrate to educational and training institutions their ability to follow a course of legal study where a significant portion of the instruction is in English.

The Curriculum

- ILEC is comprised of four tests: reading, writing, listening and speaking. Each test is based on realistic texts, tasks and topics similar to those practitioners would expect to encounter in their daily working lives.
- Some of the areas of law featured in ILEC are:
Company law, Contracts, Employment law, Real property law, Business associations, Intellectual property, Sale of goods, Negotiable instruments.

Seminars

The seminars are in-company or group seminars. The latter are held in Koblenz for groups of at least three participants.
